CAMPUS PUBLIC SAFETY PARKING & TRANSPORTATION SERVICES CONSTRUCTION PROJECT GUIDELINES DOWNTOWN CAMPUS

Construction and maintenance projects, large or small, have an impact. The intention of these guidelines is to minimize the inconvenience to the McGill community, improve the coordination between the multiple ongoing projects and facilitate smooth operations and circulation on the downtown campus.

- 1 There is no free parking at McGill including for containers and trucks carrying materials required for construction/maintenance projects. Current parking rates can be found on the McGill website at http://www.mcgill.ca/transport/parking/downtown/. There is a 20-minute grace period for deliveries.
- 2 Under most circumstances, the space needed to accommodate large deliveries must be reserved in advance. Parking & Transportation Services must be advised a minimum of two business days in advance of container/large deliveries in order to cordon off the delivery zone. Three business notice is required for cranes, as their presence may require the redirection of traffic. Note that the use of lifts needs

- 6 Campus traffic/parking rules must be followed. Parking is prohibited in noparking zones or loading zones. Short-term parking for deliveries is permitted. However, vehicles unattended to after 20 minutes will be ticketed. Parking in spaces designated for persons with disabilities is strictly prohibited. There are no exceptions and City of Montreal tickets will be issued.
- 7 As campus parking spaces are generally reserved for the McGill community, there is no parking available for major projects and very limited parking for maintenance projects.
- 8 Where space to park is available on the planned site of major projects, a maximum of five (5) access passes can be issued, for lettered vehicles only. The general contractor/site manager is responsible for the distribution of the access passes. No vehicles will be allowed to enter/exit the campus without an access pass. The access pass must remain on the vehicle while it is parked at McGill University. Escalating penalties for lost access passes will be applied.
- 9 Parking can be arranged for maintenance projects on an as-needed basis.

Note that University events (i.e. Convocation) may alter delivery hours. The McGill project manager will advise you of any such events.
