[Dr. Susie Lau](#) is an Assistant Professor at McGill University, appointed jointly in the Departments of Oncology since 2006 and Obstetrics and Gynecology since 2003.

She completed her medical degree at McMaster University in Hamilton, Ontario. She then went on to complete her residency in Obstetrics and Gynecology at McGill University and became a Fellow of the Royal College of Physicians (RCOG) and the Royal College of Obstetricians and Gynaecologists (RCOG). Following she became a gynecologic oncologist. In 2005, she moved to the Gynecologic Oncology Centre of the Jewish General Hospital. In addition to her clinical work, she completed her Master of Science degree in Epidemiology and Biostatistics at McGill University under the supervision of Dr. Eduardo Franco. She completed her research on the *Routes of Acquisition and Clearance of ASC-US Cytological Abnormalities* and received her PhD degree in 2008.

She is a member of the Régroupement des Gynécologues Oncologues du Québec (RGOQ) and served as its President from 2012 to 2014. The RGOQ is a society of gynecologic oncologists. She is also a member of the Royal College Training Committee shaping the future of the specialty.

Her research interests are diverse and include new investigational treatments and clinical trials in gynecologic cancer, as well as the application of robotic-assisted minimally invasive surgery in gynecologic oncology.
