Research Fellowship Training

Research fellows participate in didactic sessions, research projects, and observe our clinical approach to the management of patients with ocular infectious and inflammatory eye disease. However, they cannot have direct responsibility for clinical care nor perform surgical procedures. The primary responsibilities for research fellows will be to design and execute well constructed projects. They may also attend organized teaching sessions as described in the Clinical Fellowship Training section. The research training program may include exposure to clinical activities without direct patient care responsibilities. These activities include cornea and refractive surgery, external disease and uveitis clinics.
