The mandate of the Advisory Council on Sustainability is to support McGill in its positioning as a leading institution in North America on sustainability by contributing to the implementation and Sustainability Strategy, and related plans, policies, and performance indicators. The Council provides a forum for faculty, staff, students and members-at-large to provide advice on McGill campuses sustainability initiatives.

1.1. The Council:

Contributes closely to future iterations of McGill's Sustainability Strategy and related plans and policies;

- 2.3. The three (3) student representatives will be identified with the collaboration of SSMU, PGSS and MCSS
- 2.4. Members are appointed for three-year terms (for students, terms will be determined in collaboration with the students associations) but may be reappointed to serve subsequent terms. No alternates can be designated, since members are selected for their expertise, interest, and
- 2.5. If, for various reasons, a member can no longer be part of the Council, he/she will be replaced as soon as possible by someone belonging to the same membership category (described in 2.2.).
